Part 1: Safety requirements

National foreword

This British Standard is the UK implementation of EN 716-1:2017. It supersedes BS EN 716-1:2008+A1:2013, which is withdrawn.

Attention is drawn to the fact that the UK committee is of the opinion that the inclusion of a requirement for a movable side (dropline) to automatically lock when in its lowest position would increase the risk of injury and death to a child in the cot. This is because it is more likely a dropline with such a lock may be left in the lowered position during use of the item.

The UK participation in its preparation was entrusted to Technical Committee CW/1, Safety of child use and child care products.
