Therefore, the committee believes that the reference to *ordinary least squares* (OLS) in **National foreword** is not required, nor is it used elsewhere in the standard.

This British Standard is the UK implementation of EN ISO 10723:2012. It supersedes BS EN ISO 10723:2002 which is withdrawn.

The UK participation in its preparation was entrusted to Technical Committee PTI/15, Natural Gas and Gas Analysis.

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In the published standard, the term *working measurement standards* (WMS) is used to refer to reference gas mixtures. In order to align the vocabulary used in describing natural gas or gas analysis, the UK committee would have preferred to use the term *Secondary Reference Gas Mixtures*, found in BS ISO 7504:2001.
