This British Standard is the UK implementation of EN ISO 19101-1:2014. It supersedes BS EN ISO 19101:2005 which is withdrawn.

BSI, as a member of CEN, is obliged to publish EN ISO 19101-1:2014 as a British Standard. However, attention is drawn to the fact that during the development of this European and International Standard, the UK committee voted against its approval as a European or International Standard.

In the opinion of the UK committee, this Standard contains useful technical information but it is mainly applicable to those developing standards rather than the wider user community. It is the opinion of the UK committee that it would have been more appropriate if the document had been issued as a Technical Specification rather than as a European or International Standard.

The UK participation in its preparation was entrusted to Technical Committee IST/36, Geographic information.
