National foreword

This British Standard is the official English language version of EN ISO 5778:2000. It is identical with ISO 5778:1998. It supersedes BS MA 8:1983 which is withdrawn.

The UK participation in its preparation was entrusted to Technical Committee SME/32, Ships and marine technology — Steering committee, which has the responsibility to:

- aid enquirers to understand the text;
- present to the responsible international/European committee any enquiries on the interpretation, or proposals for change, and keep the UK interests informed;
- monitor related international and European developments and promulgate them in the UK.

A list of organizations represented on this committee can be obtained on request to its secretary.

NOTE When the standard was published as an international standard, the United Kingdom did not implement it as a British Standard as it was considered inferior to the existing BS MA 8:1983. The requirements contained in the international standard were not as carefully defined or as rigorous as in the British Standard. However, with the adoption of the international standard as a European Standard, the United Kingdom is obliged to implement it as the national standard superseding BS MA 8:1983. Therefore, care should be taken when following this standard that any statutory or classification society requirements are still met.
