**Clothing for protection against heat and
flame — Determination of heat transmission
on exposure to both flame and radiant heat**

National foreword

This British Standard is the UK implementation of [ISO 17492:2019](#).

The UK participation in its preparation was entrusted to Technical Committee PH/3/2, Heat and Flame Personal Protective Equipment.

A list of organizations represented on this committee can be obtained on request to its secretary.

The UK committee voted against this standard because of its requirement to report observed changes to test specimen appearance, some examples of which are listed, though the list is open-ended. The committee wanted the kind of warning that applies to other test methods in relation to avoiding such 'assessments' in product standards.

In addition, the requirement to report both the mass per unit area and the thickness of the test specimens is not one that applies to any related test methods.

This publication does not purport to include all the necessary provisions of a contract. Users are responsible for its correct application.
