# National foreword

This British Standard reproduces verbatim ISO 8368:1999 and implements it as the UK national standard. It supersedes BS 3680, Part 4, Section 4H:1986 which is withdrawn, and which was identical with ISO 8368:1985.

The UK participation in its preparation was entrusted by Technical Committee CPI/113, Hydrometry, to Subcommittee CPI/113/2, Notches, weirs and flumes, which has the responsibility to:

- aid enquirers to understand the text;
- present to the responsible international/European committee any enquiries on the interpretation, or proposals for change, and keep the UK interests informed;
- monitor related international and European developments and promulgate them in the UK.

A list of organizations represented on this subcommittee can be obtained on request to its secretary.

Since the final draft (FDIS) of ISO 8638 was approved, the UK committee has noted an inconsistency, between ISO 8368 and ISO 4377. In order to correct this inconsistency, the UK committee has advised ISO/TC 113/SC 2 accordingly, but meanwhile the following amendment should be made to BS ISO 8368:1999.

In Table 1, in the row for “Flat-V weirs”, in the column headed “Limitations”, please delete “2,5<sup>3</sup>)” and substitute “Vary”.
