Foreword

ISO (the International Organization for Standardization) is a worldwide federation of national standards bodies (ISO member bodies). The work of preparing International Standards is normally carried out through ISO technical committees. International Standard ISO 5413 was prepared by Technical Committee ISO/TC 29, *Small tools*, Sub-Committee SC 7, *Milling cutters and milling machine accessories*.

This second edition cancels and replaces the first edition (ISO 5413:1976), in which the dimensions dealt with in ISO 296 have been deleted and the tolerances for b and b_1 have been modified.
