Foreword

This second edition cancels and replaces the first edition (ISO 6107-4 : 1984), in which amendments have been made to the following terms: 2, 3, 5, 7, 8, 11, 14 and 17. Term 16 has been transferred to ISO 6107-7.

ISO 6107 consists of eight parts, under the general title *Water quality — Vocabulary*. The different parts do not have individual titles.
