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Foreword

ISO (the International Organization for Standardization) is a worldwide federation of national standards bodies (ISO member bodies). Draft International Standards adopted by the technical committees are circulated to the member bodies for voting. Publication as an International Standard requires approval by at least 75 % of the member bodies casting a vote.

International Standard ISO 6648 was prepared by Technical Committee ISO/TC 34, *Agricultural food products*, Sub-Committee SC 4, *Cereals and pulses*, in collaboration with the International Association for Cereal Science and Technology (ICC).

This second edition cancels and replaces the first edition (ISO 6648:1985), which has been technically revised.

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
